Please respond True or False to the following statements.

No.	Question	True	False
1	Stage 5 CKD can only be treated with peritoneal dialysis and not with hemodialysis.		
2	Hemodialysis and peritoneal dialysis offer the same long-term patient survival.		
3	Waiting to begin PD may increase the risk for temporary hemodialysis catheter insertion.		
4	PD catheters can be placed by a nephrologist without general anesthesia.		
5	PD commonly requires four bag changes per day, for life.		
6	PD peritonitis is a common complication and usually leads to septicemia.		
7	Protein and sodium intake should be restricted during PD.		
8	Patients must transport PD bags from the hospital to their homes.
