

Supplementary Table 2. A detailed list of causes of acute rhabdomyolysis

Category	Cause
Infection	Viruses: influenza virus, enterovirus, adenovirus, mumps virus, rotavirus, enterovirus, bocavirus, rhinovirus, adenovirus, parainfluenza virus, respiratory syncytial virus Bacteria: Mycoplasma pneumoniae, Klebsiella pneumoniae, Campylobacter, Citrobacter Othera: aspergillosis, tick-borne virus
Trauma or surgery	Fall, punishment, strenuous exercise, traffic accident, orthopedic surgery
Drug	Antihistamines, etoposide, cyclosporine, succinylcholine, antiepileptic drugs, anti-tuberculosis drugs, amoxicillin, and olanzapine
Metabolic disorders	Diabetic ketoacidosis, fatty acid oxidation disorders, metabolic myopathy, and anorexia nervosa presenting as metabolic complications
Connective tissue disorders	Kawasaki disease, Henoch–Schönlein purpura, dermatomyositis
