

Supplementary Table 2. GFR categories in CKD classification

GFR category	GFR (mL/min/1.73 m ²)	Description
G1	≥90	Normal or increased GFR
G2	60–89	Mildly decreased GFR
G3a	45–59	Mildly to moderately decreased GFR
G3b	30–44	Moderately to severely decreased GFR
G4	15–29	Severely decreased GFR
G5	<15	Kidney failure

CKD, chronic kidney disease; GFR, glomerular filtration rate.

Relative to young adult level: evidence/markers of kidney damage are required for GFR category G1 and G2 to fulfill the criteria for CKD.
